International opportunities for water companies



Cleveland Water Alliance (CWA) Open Innovation Challenge

This programme aims to solve real-world challenges within the water industry, connecting innovators with grant funding or potential purchasers. Participants receive access to testbeds to prove their market-driven innovations in partnership with industry leader.

They are requesting technologies and innovative concepts around a significant market gap: the physical detection of the material(s) comprising drinking water utility service lines without having to dig down to the service-line pipes for identification. Participants may be eligible to receive grant dollars to assist in bringing their solutions to market.

Successful applicants can receive between 3 000 and 25 000 US dollars.

Below you can see the timeline breakdown in terms of the application:

- Letters of Intent (LOI) Due: Wednesday, July 5, 2023 at 3p ET
- Proposals Due: Wednesday, July 26, 2023 at 3p ET
- Grantees Announced: Wednesday, August 16 Friday August 25, 2023

Funding opportunity - The Knowledge Lump Sum scheme is still ongoing—until funds are exhausted!

European SMEs looking for external support to boost their company's development and competitiveness can benefit from the **Knowledge lump-sum scheme**! It offers the possibility of financing training or consultancy services.



The call opened on 7/06 at 12pm and will remain open until funds run out, on a "first come, first served" basis. Funding ranges from €2,000 to €4,000 per application, with a maximum of 2 applications per SME.

The mission will take place in Mexico city from 4th to 6th of September 2023, at the same time and place as <u>Aquatech Mexico</u>, <u>Green Expo, Intersolar Mexico</u> & <u>Mexico Wind Power</u>.

The preliminary program includes:

- Monday 4th
 - Political and economic briefing with the EU Delegation in Mexico. Presentation of current programs and opportunities for European SMEs.
 - Training session on how to both protect and enforce their Intellectual Property (IP) rights when doing business with/in Latin American countries with the Latin America IP SME Helpdesk, an initiative of the EU Commission.
 - Meeting with the Interamerican Bank of Development presentation of their Water and sanitation (public sector) services and their private sector and funding opportunities.
- Tuesday 5th
 - o Personalized B2B session -tbc.
- Wednesday 6th
 - Visits of trade fairs and customized exhibitors' itineraries.

A financial support of 1.500€ per company will again be offered to join the trip and visit the fair in Mexico City.

It will be held in Tunis, Borj Cédria and Sousse (tbc) in the last week of September 2023. This is an opportunity for EU enterprises to get to know the opportunities that this country offers in the water and energy sectors. The participants will meet and establish collaborations with local stakeholders and companies and start internationalising in Tunisia.

The mission will include a one-day-event conference, visits to local partners and technoparks, and matchmaking activities to create new partnerships with Tunisian organisations.

The preliminary programme includes:

- 25/09 Arrival in Tunis and dinner with the EU participating companies
- 26/09 Presentations, round-tables and meetings with key stakeholders
- 27/09 Visit to Ecopark Borj-Cédria and labs, including matchmaking activities and round-tables on water and energy
- 28/09 Visit to Technopark in Monastir, including matchmaking activities (to be confirmed)
- 29/09 Return trip to Europe
